Who should participate?

Ideal candidates are individuals interested in learning about the inner workings of Moore County and have an interest in becoming more involved in community affairs. Private and public sector individuals, who serve in middle to upper level management positions in their respective companies/organizations, are encouraged to participate. The class is limited to 25 participants annually.

Time Commitment
