# MCLI OVERVIEW

## What is MCLI?

In 1989, the Moore County Chamber of Commerce established and sponsored the MCLI. The goal was to develop a broader base of informed, committed, and qualified individuals capable of providing dynamic leadership for Moore County. During the past 25 years, over 450 people have graduated from MCLI.

## Who should participate?

Ideal candidates are Chamber Member individuals interested in learning about the inner workings of Moore County and have an interest in becoming more involved in community affairs. Private and public sector individuals, who serve in middle to upper level management positions in their respective companies/organizations, are encouraged to participate. The class is limited to 25 participants annually.

# MCLI TIMELINE

## Time Commitment

There are eleven sessions during the calendar year. Sessions start in January with a two-day retreat. The class meets monthly from 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Participants are required to attend all sessions. Any waiver from the attendance policy must be approved by the MCLI Chairpersons in advance. ## The Value

MCLI helps participants understand the dynamics of effective leadership and decision making. Participants will study community facets including, but not limited to, education, government, health care, etc. In addition participants implement their own individual leadership styles and develop their leadership skills through participation in community projects.

## The Cost

Tuition is \$895, which includes the retreat, all meals and course materials. Partial scholarships are available. Upon acceptance in the program a non-refundable down payment of \$225 is due by December 10, 2014. The balance of \$670 is due by January 7, 2015. **Do not submit payment with application.**
