MCLI PROGRAM INFORMATION AND APPLICATION PROCESS

There is no better way than the Moore County Leadership Institute (MCLI) to develop your leadership capabilities, get to know the Moore County area and discover ways to contribute to your community. MCLI provides you with the opportunity to grow both personally and professional. You will learn from community leaders and experts about local history, business, civic issues and community involvement. You will be educated with leadership training that will prepare you to assume new roles in the future.

MCLI is a program of the Moore County Chamber of Commerce. This comprehensive program is designed to create an environment where you can Discover Moore County, Expand your networks, Grow your leadership skills and Serve the community. With the overall mission on the MCLI Program to Cultivate and Connect Moore Leaders. Participants will be involved in eleven (10) interactive classes, looking at history, current and future issues or opportunities facing Moore County. In addition, there is an evening social activity during the 2-day retreat, a graduation dinner in December and 1 leadership training program (normally held in October). The participants are also responsible for completing a minimum of one (1) but up to two (2) group projects that will require additional time away from the office or after standard business hours (times determined by the actual groups).

Benefits of MCLI

MCLI benefits both you and the community. The knowledge and understanding gained from the training program will prepare individuals for leadership roles in both their organizations and the community. Because of the MCLI program, graduates are more knowledgeable and are better equipped to make key decisions affecting their own organizations, the community and themselves.

During the MCLI program, participants will gain many leadership qualities. In addition, you will be able to look at your own community with new perspective. Areas of leadership focus will include, but are not limited to, self-awareness, empathy, vision, passion, balance, volunteerism, and community leadership.
