

Inspiring Excellence in Not-for-Profit Leadership

Peak performing non-profit boards serve their constituents and our community better. The Not-for-Profit Management Training Program is a premier program dedicated to providing leadership development, resources, training, and best practices about peak-performing boards. New, veteran and prospective board members, as well as executive directors and staff, will all benefit from participating in the Not-for-Profit Management Training Program by learning and acting upon the principles of dynamic board and staff leadership.

The Moore County Chamber of Commerce designed this Program as six half-day sessions over a 5-month timeframe. The program is open to Chamber members and non-Chamber members and is limited to no more than 15 participants. Sessions are taught by industry leaders from the North Carolina Center for Non-Profits, association management professionals and local leaders involved with Not-for-Profits.

This program is specifically created to make a direct impact here in our community. Over 50 individuals have graduated to date and are making a contribution to our community as a result of participating in this program. Individuals participate because they want to help an organization fulfill its mission, enhance career development opportunities, work for a cause they believe in, and develop a strong sense of personal responsibility for the area's future. Take a moment and learn how you can make an impact here in Moore County.



August 14, 2014 *Creating and Building Effective Not-for-Profit Boards*

This session highlights the structure of Not-for-Profit Boards, how they can be created and how you can continue to build upon these Boards to ensure they remain effective in their goals and objectives. Accountability practices related to policies, procedures, meeting structure and delegation of tasks will also be covered. Participants will also receive an overview on methods to recruit new board members, while focusing on diversity, inclusion and creating a board succession plan.

September 4, 2014 *The Story of Not-for Profits*

This session addresses the purpose, benefits and challenges in the nonprofit sector, as well as assesses a nonprofit's function and viability. In addition this session will cover best practices, challenges and successes of local Not-for-Profit Boards within the community and the State of North Carolina.

September 18, 2014 *Mission, Vision, Values and Strategic Planning*

This session addresses the development of a nonprofit's mission, vision, and core values. There will also be an overview of the creation, monitoring, evaluation and revision of a Not-for-Profit strategic plan and how it relates to the organization's growth and development. Once this established how to ensure your plan doesn't remain on a shelf but moving it forward in today's economy to ensure your mission is being met.

October 9, 2014 *Governance and Compliance Issues*

This session highlights the legal and financial responsibilities as a Board member and a Not-for-Profit organization.

October 23, 2014 *Fundraising in Today's economy*

This session will highlight the many ways a Not-for-Profit can fundraise in today's economy. With the increasing number of organizations in a community one has to become more creative in how to ensure budget obligations and your organizations needs are being met.

November 13, 2014 *Making A Difference*

Capitalizing on how you can develop resources to fund your non-profit organization. In addition this session summarizes the entire Non Profit program. Participants will discuss their observations of board meetings they have attended* and how each board meeting incorporated the various components of not-for-profit management.

December 3, 2014

Evening Graduation Ceremony in conjunction with the Moore County Leadership Institute.
