



New Life for Iconic Building: SP Brewing Taps Carthage for Expansion

There is a proverb that says, "Do not be afraid of growth; be afraid of standing still."

While much of the area surrounding downtown Carthage is in the midst of movin' and groovin', the downtown area itself has been in what seems a perpetual holding pattern. But hold onto your beer mugs, because Southern Pines Brewing is planning on movin' and brewin' into the town's iconic Buggy Building.

After decades of disrepair and thwarted hopes of revitalizing

the historic 1856 Tyson and Jones Buggy Co. Building, the time has finally come.

What is arguably Carthage's most famous building was built as the result of its most famous industry, the production of carriages in the late 1800s and early 1900s.

Meanwhile, one of Moore County's most recent success stories, the Southern Pines Brewing Co., was built as the result of a retired Green Beret at Fort Bragg

looking for something to do after his service career. In 2021, the company was voted "Best New Business" in the local Best of the Pines contest, and in April was voted Best of Show in the Carolinas Championship of Beer.

About 166 years ago, Thomas Tyson and Alexander Kelly began developing what was soon to become the most well-known carriage factory in the world. This major Carthage enterprise reached its peak in 1890, turning out about 3,000 vehicles a year. The Tyson and Jones Buggy Co. earned the reputation for producing the "Cadillac of carriages."

But time and technology caught up and surpassed the business. The last buggy was delivered in 1925 to Neil S. Blue of RaefoRoad The demise of the building has been ongoing ever since.

Micah Nieubauer, CEO and co-founder of Southern Pines Brewing, began talking with town officials and local economic development leaders about an expansion plan centered around Carthage.

"I threw my hat in the ring" after months of working out the details and an Aug. 24 public hearing, Niebauer said. He will own the building, planning a close before the end of the year.

"I am honored to preserve the last vestiges of what put

Carthage on the map," he said. "Our company takes our mission of building and fostering community more importantly than anything we do."

The future plan is extensive. Nieubauer rattles off what he intends to do:

- provide hearty pizzas fired in an open kitchen's pizza ovens;
 lunch, dinner and delivery service, including "quick delicious options for the courthouse crowd";
 - a large basement
 brewery focused on using
 local grains, unique
 fermentation blends and
 one-of-a-kind brews to
 replicate and replace
 the need for imports;
 multiple bars on two
 floors; and
 historical touches,
 decor and original details
 throughout the building,
 including "hopefully,

from the ceiling," he said. And that's just the inside. Niebauer also has

buggies and hanging it

purchased surrounding property, including Dean's Gold N Guns, that he plans to remove.

His hope is that the new brewery can be seen from the main road and can soon be used for the "event venue many of us have hoped to see here." He plans to install a large grassy lawn surrounded by a low fence that will encourage people to sit outside. The outside property will include an area for a large stage, several brick fire pits, an outside bar, a semi-covered area for 75 to 100 people, then additional seating and areas scattered across the lawn. Niebauer is pleased with the parking situation as well.

While Niebauer has quickly built a sizable beer business in the area, he has not yet had the opportunity to take a stab at a common-factor for breweries: preserving local history.

"That piece is huge for us," he said. "We are taking this preservation piece very seriously."

In 2019, UNC Greensboro's Bryan School of Business and Economics studied the impact of taprooms in North Carolina and explained the connection: "The empty factory spaces and mill buildings are ideally suited for brewing operations. The rent is affordable, the space is ample, and the water supply is generous.

Developer Buys Downtown Village Building for HQ

C.F. Smith Property has had a notable footprint in Moore County, but its headquarters has remained over the years farther south, in Rockingham.

Neil Robinette, the company's chief executive officer, is changing that and will be bringing his family company to Pinehurst. C.F. Smith recently purchased Magnolia Place, a downtown Pinehurst building often referred to as the Razook's Building, for slightly more than \$5 million last month. Razook's was an upscale women's clothing store

that operated out of the site for 87 years until 2006. C.F. Smith was founded in 1964 and has more than 10 million square feet of property. The move from Rockingham is just one of the many C.F. Smith ventures in the area over the years, including the Pinecroft shopping center in Taylortown anchored by Harris Teeter, Southern Pines' Marketplace, a complex that includes the new Ashley furniture store and surrounding retail, and Lowe's Home Improvement on U.S. 15-501.

"We have a small, incredible team of 15 and we are looking forward to continuing our friendships and business dealings in such a vibrant community. After we move into that top floor, we will literally be able to see the history that we are now a part of."

The building was sold by the late Barry Lerman's family. Lerman purchased the building in 2017. He was a respected member of the community and served on the Moore County Airport Authority Board before passing away earlier this year.

Robinette said the transition should be seamless with existing tenants and the company plans to continue working with the current property management group, Sandhills Rentals. "Their role in this has been extremely helpful and professional." The building has approximately 23,000 square feet with street-level retail, executive suites. and basement-level office space. While the existing businesses will operate as

usual, Robinette hopes to do a modest amount of remodeling on the area to be used as the company's new headquarters.

"The area that will be our office space was renovated in the early 2000s and is in great shape. We will likely hire a local interior design firm along with making some small adjustments to the floor plan so that it will fit our team."

The company, which does business in 23 states, focuses primarily on real estate development, acquisition, financing, property management, marketing and build-to-suit services. Its niche is office, medical, retail and commercial space in upscale urban and suburban areas.

A private, family-owned and operated business, the company manages all of portfolio holdings.

Robinette said that he is especially proud of the repurposed historical buildings the company has acquired — like this most recent Pinehurst deal — and the three buildings and courtyard at 132, 154, and 176 NW Broad St. in downtown Southern Pines. Many locals attribute that redevelopment as a catalyst to downtown retail vibrancy.

"It was a challenging project, but today I see many folks utilizing the quasi-public space daily to eat lunch or relax on the benches," he said. "There is no feeling more rewarding than being part of a team that brings real estate to life with community-enhancing projects."

Robinette constantly stresses the mission of the company "to create community value through meaningful relationships" and knows that was part of the rationale for this recent investment.

The American Dream, NC Style

Claude F. Smith Jr. was 12 when he bought a combine to harvest grain. Three years later, he bought a crop dusting plane. In the 1950s, he asked his father to help him finance the purchase of the Marston Broom Factory in Marston. In 1954, he received a U.S. patent for reinventing the modern broom. In 1957, he was awarded another patent that revolutionized broom making.

From that point on, he collected royalties from manufacturers around the world and dedicated his life to improving his beloved state.

Smith quickly became a large part of the movers and shakers in North Carolina. During the 1960s, Smith became involved in the development of the NC Speedway and later, the International

The end result is that brewing operations bring new life to old and abandoned areas."

Coming as no surprise to Niebauer, the study also revealed that "most consumers crave camaraderie,, not inebriation. They gather in taprooms because they want to feel connected to the people and the places around them."

Nieubauer believes that community is what makes the new Carthage venture so exciting.

"To be able to expand our footprint in our home, the Sandhills, is just incredible," he said. "I don't want to put the buggy before the horse, but we believe we are going to bring back this amazing building and contribute some of that amazing value back to the community."

Dragway and the Darlington Dragway.

He founded the Western Sirloin Steakhouse Restaurant Group; played a prominent role in the development of St. James Plantation, a 10,000-acre private, gated plantation in Southport; established an air freight business to transport cargo for GM, Ford and Burlington Industries, among others; developed Pinehurst National Golf Club — now Pinehurst No. 9; purchased Pinehurst Plantation — now known as Mid South Country Club, the area's only Arnold Palmer-designed golf course; and founded the Claude F. Smith Foundation supporting local nonprofits, churches and charities.

Robinette joined the company in 2014 after Smith, his grandfather, passed away. In those eight years, the company has executed more than \$200 million in real estate value from development projects, acquisitions, new leases and dispositions. The company has also developed two solar farms, with plans to ultimately operate up to 100,000 acres of solar projects.

Robinette is part of The Pilot's 40 Under 40 class of 2022, recognizing Moore County leaders and contributors to the community. He was also among 19 to be named to the 2020 class of Trailblazers by Business North Carolina magazine.

An active board member of Moore County Partners in Progress, Robinette is also a governor-appointed member of the North Carolina Interagency Coordinating Council for Children from Birth to Five with Disabilities. His youngest daughter was born with a profound hearing loss and "whatever value that we can add to the state to help support other families who are going through this is certainly something that we want to try to do," he said. "It's definitely overwhelming going through this kind of thing, especially situations that are a lot more significant and severe than what we've gone through."

In mid-January, the business officially changed its name to C.F. Smith Property Group from Tri-Cities, Inc.

Intersection of Past, Present

"We are proud of our family's history," Robinette said, "and wanted to recognize my grandfather in our name change. His story really is amazing and we wanted our name to honor him.
"This new building is also a small part of the history within the village. I wish we knew a little more about the building, but we are

hoping to dig into that later."

The Razook's building had more meager beginnings than what it is now. The building has been called the Merrow Building, the O'Brien Building, Lot #801, Magnolia Place and the Razook Building.

According to an application submitted for historical recognition of the building years ago, "By 1918 a large, two-and-a-half-story frame building, known as the O'Brien Building, had been erected at the corner of Chinquapin and Magnolia roads. Around 1934, William C. Holleyman remodeled the building, sheathing it in brick, creating more modern shop windows, and adding more dormers. The Razooks store then occupied it."

The man who built and owned the original building was Edmond L. Merrow, one of Pinehurst's original and most prolific photographers. He designed the building as a photography studio. He hired his former driver, E.C. Eddy, as an assistant.

Eddy was forever taking the shots that Merrow likely did not want to do. He was the first person to take an aerial photo in North Carolina — and one of the first in the country. Multiple photos exist of him on a roof or a ladder taking photos.

After Merrow died in 1922, Eddy became as successful, if not more, than his former employer. He decided to set up his own studio. The location? The area that Robinette and C.F. Smith revitalized in Southern Pines. Robinette was delighted with the discovery and is proud of yet another connection to the local community.

Heating Up With New Kiln, the Kindness of Clean Used Bedding Grows

It has been two years, but the sanitizing "kiln" that will provide a local foundation with more mattresses for people in need of bedding is finally here. Keith Moneymaker and Amy Sexauer can barely contain their excitement.

Moneymaker, the second-generation owner of Sweet Dreams Mattresses and More in Southern Pines and Sanford, established the Dreams 4 All Foundation in 2016. Sexauer, the executive director, is a military veteran who joined the organization in the summer of 2019.

The local nonprofit has delivered new or reused/sanitized mattresses to families facing economic hardship or adversity and fire departments across the area. To date, it has assisted more than 3,000 families and organizations, including local fire stations, Habitat for Humanity of the N.C. Sandhills, Tambra Place, Bethany House, Friend to Friend, and Samaritan Colony, among others.

Moneymaker and Sexauer have also pledged to give every Ukrainian refugee arriving in North Carolina a bed. "If you are operating a business in your community, the first thing you

need to consider is what you are doing for that community," Moneymaker said.

While both know this is potentially an expensive pledge, they feel "confident we can do it with our customers and supporters," Moneymaker said. While the mattresses will be donated, Dreams 4 All will be purchasing frames, box springs and coordinating all deliveries across the state. The nonprofit is hoping to raise \$100,000 for the effort "from anyone that feels called to give a dollar or a thousand or any other amount."

This new kiln does not look like the normal pottery sealer. It looks more like the back of a delivery truck covered in aluminum foil.

The Kiln is In

Regardless of appearance, it does the job. The mattress inspector, the fire inspector, the building inspector, the gas installation people and the kiln company representative all concurred on Friday.

Moneymaker hopes that this kiln will now allow his nonprofit to "stockpile clean mattresses for when they are needed most."

Prior to the arrival of the kiln, Dreams 4 All was not able

to provide large numbers of sanitized mattresses all at once or as quickly as needed. Sexauer's team had to send the mattresses away individually for the sanitization process.

Moneymaker has shared his nonprofit model with mattress retailers, where these businesses can join Dreams 4 All as affiliate partners.

"The idea is they will be able to do what I've done here," he said. "I'm teaching them how to give back to their own communities."

Sexauer believes the sincerity of this nonprofit has translated to

others wanting to get on boaRoad

"We have leaned into our relationships to help and ask for support," she said. "Our authenticity for helping people has been obvious."

Moneymaker agrees. "I've found the more I give, the more mattresses I sell. What you give comes back tenfold. It is a beautiful, well-balanced business charity model."

Dreams 4 All has also partnered with several large mattress companies, including Tempur-Pedic, Sealy, and Stearns & Foster.

On April 7 and 8, 2022 the first Dreams 4 All National Summit took place with meetings,

discussions and planning with the hopes that other mattress businesses across the country will participate in the process of accepting used mattresses. The guest speaker was Mike Erwin, executive director of Team RWB, a health and wellness organization focused on veterans. Afterwards, attendees participated in a large mattress delivery to Samaritan Colony in Rockingham, a nonprofit residential treatment facility helping men — and soon women — struggling with substance abuse problems in the Sandhills area.

Moneymaker shared what he believes is the simple secret of the success he has seen with this nonprofit process. "This model is better for the community and the environment, improving culture and morale, enhancing support networks, all the while building businesses."

A Gripping Performance: Golf Pride Is Hands On With Innovation

Golf Pride has lots of reasons to be proud.

Arguably one of Moore County's most well-known global names, the world's No. 1 golf grip company is ready to talk about innovations. The OG of golf grips is always up for discovering the next big thing in the game, whether that's with its new retail shopping concept on-site, an office that seems to have a little bit of everything needed to bring about the latest and greatest or with its core tenets focused on authenticity and thoughtfulness.

"Modern innovators" is probably not the phrase one would associate with a company established in the decade synonymous with World War II. But from the very beginning of the company's meager beginnings, "innovation is what this company is about," President Jamie Ledford explains. After all, it was company founder Thomas L. Fawick who had that original innovative idea that rubber grips were much more "grippable" than the

leather that had been part of golf clubs for over a century.

Meager no more, Golf Pride's parent company, Eaton, had a \$19.63 billion year in 2021. Audrey Rodriguez, the company's head in global brand marketing, believes that "staying innovative" after all these years and not resting on its laurels "is the really impressive piece. We truly want to provide what you haven't seen before and what works for you, whatever your golf game looks like."

What better way to prove how serious you are about innovation than to name your 36,000-square-foot jaw-droppingly modern and chic headquarters the "Global Innovation Campus." Located near the entrance of Pinehurst No. 8, off Murdocksville Road, the facility looks like it's in the running for any and every office space award, including accolades for "Office I Wish I Lived In," "Is This How The Cool Kids Work?" and "Are You Sure We Are In Moore County?" The campus replaced former offices in Southern Pines and combined corporate offices, a "rapid prototype" laboratory and, now, the beginnings of a consumer interactive wing under one roof.

A golf club's material, head angle or driving capability may get all the sizzle, but none of it matters if it flies out of the golfer's hand with every swing. That makes the grip important to the rip, and Golf Pride is innovating with the same intense focus as, for instance, a shaft or club head manufacturer. Even today, more than 50 percent of Golf Pride's revenue comes from new products that have been created since 2014, Ledford said.

"Product innovation has been a huge factor behind our growth over the past few years," he said.

Within the rapid-prototype testing ground in the back of the campus, engineers in golf shirts gather around large metal tables. They are, literally, burning rubber — you can smell it in the lab — and signs

pepper the wall reminding everyone that you will be sorry if you take pictures or anything else.

Part of the purpose of this workshop "is to compress the time it takes to develop a new grip. We want to fail faster on stuff that doesn't work," Ledford said. "By reducing the time it takes to innovate a product, we can run more ideas."

The newest step in that forward march is the Retail Lab. At almost 1,000 square feet, the space is a retail store full of exclusive

products and merchandise and a place to select and install the best Golf Pride golf grips for "what's best for the golfer, regardless of his or her skill level."

But most importantly, "it's an inviting place to spend time, ask questions about golf and grips, drop off clubs, or get in and out quickly, whatever works best for you," tour technician Andy Bare explains. It is the first of its kind and will allow the company to both study and showcase the "relationship between the grip and the hands," he says. Because, Bare emphasized multiple times at a recent open house, "a grip is a golfer's only physical connection to his or her clubs."

Hoping for both fun and function, the lab looks quite a bit like a modern sports bar, except instead of being offered the beer on tap, the golfer gets, "What golf grip can I get ya?" The goal is to treat customers as a professional would experience: a grip consultation and personal installation experience.

While Golf Pride is selling its wares, it is also gathering insights. "There's a lot we will better understand regarding consumer preferences," said Eric Gibson, global head of marketing. "Selecting the appropriate model can be challenging and we hope to solve that problem in addition to learning what golfers want."

Ultimately, the Golf Pride Lab team hopes to evolve the retail experience across its retail partners, its original equipment manufacturers and its eCommerce channels.

Bare is a Moore County native; he graduated from Pinecrest High School in 1999. He has been part of the golf world in a variety of roles, but this one "is a keeper."

He and the 50 employees at Golf Pride's headquarters are proud of their location and happy to be part of a community that has provided them the "small-town likability without the typical metropolis headaches," Bare happily notes.

In his role as president, Ledford is "always excited to bring guests and clients to the mother ship. I mean, look at all the great opportunities to do pretty much anything you want without having to deal with so many of the negatives associated with 'city-life.' And we couldn't be more proud of this building and the people in it."

Rodriguez moved here from the Bay Area. While she misses some parts of it, "Moore County has welcomed me with open arms. I love being able to walk to Southern Pines and be part of the community."

Golf Pride has also gotten involved in the local community, serving as a lead corporate sponsor for First Tee of the Sandhills, in addition to supporting the United Way of Moore County, Relay for Life, Shakespeare in the Pines and USGA local events. Golf Pride has taken an innovative approach with their cultural decisions as well, according to Rodriguez. She explained that even when determining the language to use or the names for products, "We have tried to stay away from that 'inside baseball language' that can be intimidating. Even choices as simple as that can eliminate one piece of disparity."

In June 2022, Golf Pride kicked off the start of the U.S. Women's Open week with an evening event to introduce its women's equity platform that celebrates the female golfer and the unique connections that tie them to the game, highlighting their stories, journeys and contributions to the game of golf. The event included a special appearance by golfers and influencers on and off the course such as Tisha Alyn, Emma Carpenter, Aimee Cho, Tiffany Mack Fitzgerald, Hannah Gregg and Emmy Martin. It also brought together a female chef, a female DJ, and female-owned companies to provide services for the event.

While "80 percent of tour pros use Golf Pride grips without endorsement," Ledford is just as proud that "regardless of how well you play the game or how long you have been doing it, Golf Pride can continue to feel inviting to all people."



Building Permits

Building permits must be obtained before any construction or remodeling of an existing building can be undertaken. Prior to any work, contact the local community administrative office for guidelines and permit applications.



Driver's License and License Plates

A driver's license, good for four years, must be acquired within 30 days of becoming a North Carolina resident. When registering for the first time in the state, residents must bring proof of mileage, name of liability insurance company, and policy number as well as previous certificate or title. The license may be obtained from the Driver's License Division of the North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles located at 521 South Sandhills Boulevard (US 1 North) in Aberdeen. New residents must register a motor vehicle by the expiration of the time granted by the reciprocity agreement between North Carolina and the prior state of residence (usually 30 days) or when gainful employment is accepted, whichever occurs first. To register a vehicle, registrants must present a valid North Carolina identification cwaRoad Most Vehicle & License Plate Renewal Offices are open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Votina

Forms that are received by the county Board of Elections office or postmarked by the deadline are accepted as valid applications for the upcoming election. Also, agency and DMV voter registration transactions that are completed by the deadline are accepted as valid for the upcoming election. Applicants will be notified by the county Board of Elections of their precinct and polling place assignments.





Although more popular at big events and festivals, live entertainment in Moore County is a regular occurrence. Residents have opportunities throughout the year to catch a performance of the Carolina Philharmonic Orchestra, and the Arts Council hosts a Classical Concert Series that brings in talent from all over the world.

For those interested in more contemporary styles of music, Moore County has regular concert series, such as First Friday in Southern Pines, and Live after Five in Pinehurst. Many of these performances offer free admission, and are presented by the county's best venues, such as the Sunrise Theater in Southern Pines. In the spring and summer, artists perform outside to accommodate larger crowds and take advantage of nicer weather.

There are also festivals throughout the year that support local bluegrass bands and Southern rock groups, such as the annual Buggy Festival in Carthage and Farmer's Day in Robbins.

For those who fancy live theater, Broadway shows, ballet and world-renowned speakers, the Given Performing Arts Center at the nearby University of North Carolina at Pembroke offers access to them on one of the finest stages in the state. Carolina Performing Arts Theatre Group is the resident theater company at The Encore Center in Southern Pines. The newly renovated Bradshaw Performing Arts Center at Sandhills Community College brings a variety of live theater, dance and music, as well as the Ruth Pauley Lecture Series. This series, sponsored by the college, the Moore County League of Women Voters, the American Association of University Women and Moore County Schools, introduces noted speakers to the Sandhills. The goal of the lectures is to deepen understanding of key issues and encourage public participation in their resolution.

Moore County isn't lacking in the literary department either. The Weymouth Center for the Arts and Humanities became home to the North Carolina Literary Hall of Fame in 1996. This exciting cultural trademark was made possible by former Weymouth Center resident James Boyd. He made his living writing and publishing, and has been accredited with launching the "Southern Literary Renaissance" in the 1920s and '30s. Boyd's former study – now known as the Boyd Room – is used to host book readings featuring North Carolina's most talented authors.

The county's artistic flair wouldn't be complete without its historical pottery scene. Residents travel across the county to browse the sprawling selection of clay-made crafts in Cameron and Robbins. In fact, Cameron hosts the biannual Antique and Collectibles Fair to celebrate the vast number of local potters and antique shops.

Moore County's art scene entertains the classics, and recognizes its Southern roots. From traditional art forms to some good ol' bluegrass, residents can engage in a variety of cultural opportunities throughout the year.

Moore County Schools' Strategic Plan incorporates a vision of striving to be the standard for excellence in education in North Carolina, and its mission is that all students will graduate with the skills, knowledge, character and education to become proud and successful citizens of the United States of America. The county's 23 public schools offer students challenging lessons taught by licensed professionals with years of experience in the field and in the classroom. In fact, nearly half of the school system's certified employees have obtained a master's degree or higher in their field of expertise or in teaching.

Prior to advancing to a K-12 school, it is essential that all children have the opportunity to build early developmental skills that will enhance their success in a rigorous and innovative academic curriculum. MCS utilizes a research-based program called Creative Curriculum in all of its preschool classes that focuses on principles of early childhood development. Through a partnership with North Carolina's Smart Start program, preschoolers are prepared for success in kindergarten by enhanced readiness in the areas of literacy, basic mathematics and social emotional skills.

MCS' Digital Learning Initiative provides a Chromebook device for all students grades 2 through 12, for use in school and at home. Kindergarten and first-grade students are provided an iPad for use at school and at home. Elementary, middle and high school teachers engage students with rigorous and innovative teaching and learning opportunities. District and school opportunities that support students to be future ready include the STEM initiative, which includes robotics programs in grades K-8, science kits for grades K-8, CyberPatriot teams at all three high schools, and summer STEM camps that introduce students to STEM-focused careers such as computer programming, forensics, robotics, engineering, forestry, health sciences and aviation. Moore County schools' are recognized as leaders in STEM across the state and have been awarded multiple Digital Teaching and Learning Grants from the the Department of Public Instruction.

Moore County's excellent high schools make it easy for students to successfully transition into college. SAT scores consistently meet or exceed state and national averages, and all three schools offer Advanced Placement courses, enabling students to start earning college credits in high school. Sandhills Community College also allows high school students in Moore and Hoke counties to take courses prior to graduation exempt of tuition fees.

In an effort to partner more effectively with Moore County's homeschool population, MCS offers a "blend+ed" program for K-12 students. For grades K-5, students attend face-to-face instruction two days per week with the remaining days spent with instruction at home with materials provided by MCS teachers. Students enrolled have the option to participate in extracurricular activities and art, music and physical education classes. For grades 6-12, students can build a course load that meets their individual needs, utilizing either traditional in-person learning or online classes in coordination with their homeschool classes. Students in grades 6-12 blend+ed may also participate in athletics and any other extracurricular activities that happen after the normal school day ends.

For a fully virtual option, MCS offers Connect! Virtual Academy. Students learn grade-level content from a certified and fully-licensed MCS teacher on pace with their peers in face-to-face instruction. Sessions are offered both live as well as recorded. Housing

Whether moving across state lines or just across town, new residents benefit from experts who stand at the ready to help young professionals, growing families, military personnel and retirees find an ideal fit for their lifestyle.









Local Realtors serve as the frontline to help prospective residents navigate the diversity of choices in neighborhoods and homes. These professionals know the assets of towns comprising Moore County, understand the many emotions flooding buyers, and are skilled negotiators, all of which combine to make Realtors a home buyer's best friend. Some Moore County agents offer small perks for their clients — little touches to help make the home buying and shopping experience run smoothly. Buyers should be sure to ask what kinds of free services might be available, such as a notary public, copier, fax or internet.

Agencies also provide free maps, local event listings and coloring books for the little ones. Residents seeking rental properties should check with real estate agencies, many of which provide rental listings among their services.

The Moore County Home Builders Association inspires new and existing residents with its annual Home & Garden Expo each spring. The four-day event brings builders, designers, decorators, landscapers and home retailers together under one roof. Plus, the Association's annual "Home of the Year" competition presents a unique opportunity to see the latest and most excellent trends in new homes and updated existing structures.

The communities that make up Moore County are accessible to one another and to neighboring cities with a good transportation infrastructure, making for an easy commute to Fort Bragg or the Triangle. Close-knit subdivisions, walkable downtowns and roomy farm communities complement one another, giving residents ample choices to suit their needs.









With the emergence of the craft brewing industry, it's no surprise that Moore County has breweries, wineries, cider houses and a distillery (coming soon) of its own. The trendsetter was Rail House Brewery, which was opened nearly a decade ago by veterans in historic downtown Aberdeen. Following suit, three retired Green Berets traded in their boots for barley and started brewing beers like Man of Law IPA and Duck Hook cream ale, opening Southern Pines Brewing Company in late 2014. Both breweries have family friendly taprooms and are hosts to community events throughout the year, including Southern Pines Brewery's Pints and Poses yoga classes, networking mixers and outdoor concerts.

Pinehurst Resort opened a brewery in late 2018 tucked just a few blocks from the resort's Carolina Hotel. It occupies what was the original village steam plant that once powered all of Pinehurst. Boasting the building's original brick facade and steel windows, it is now a restaurant and brewery serving craft beers and barbecue.

Hatchet Brewing Company opened in the fall of 2019 in downtown Southern Pines.

Cypress Bend Vineyards, located in nearby Wagram, has been cultivating over 30 acres of muscadine variety grapes into 16 table wines since 2005. They host Jazzy Fridays weekly under a bigtop, with musical guests like The Embers and the Band of Oz.

James Creek Cider House harvests 65 varieties of apples in Cameron to create signature small batch ciders that they sell across the state at select bottle shops, farmers markets and locally at area wine shops, pubs and restaurants.

Southern Pines Growler Company and Southern Pines Brewing Company both expanded operations in 2020, opening tap rooms in new locations.











If fitness is your thing, you'll certainly be pleased with the diverse options this community has to offer. Area trails like the Greenway weave their way through the Sandhills providing safe paths for walking, running, biking and even horseback riding. Running clubs have become a popular pastime for enthusiasts, often beginning or ending at neighborhood watering holes like the Southern Pines Growler Shop.

Other group fitness activities found around town include Fit4Mom, Stroller Strides and Sassy Tappers, all sponsored by the village of Pinehurst.

FirstHealth offers the area's largest traditional gym, the FirstHealth Fitness Center in Pinehurst. Other gyms like Anytime Fitness provide around the clock access to members. There are a number of concept studios like CrossFit, Pure Barre and Forte Fitness that each offer unique training models in addition to a wide range of yoga and Pilates studios throughout the community, all helping to ensure that no matter your exercise preference, you'll be able to find your niche in Moore County.



If your family is into athletics, there are a host of choices available for kids of all ages. Southern Pines, Aberdeen and Pinehurst have thriving recreational departments offering seasonal sport leagues. Additionally, AC Sandhills, a privately run sports league, supports recreational and traveling club soccer, volleyball and lacrosse. The Sandhills Optimist Club offers fall football and spring baseball for ages 6-13, while the Sandhills Lacrosse League has a local travel lacrosse team for high school boys who wish to play at a competitive level. The O'Neal Swim Team is a year-round competitive swim team for all ages. Football players are primed for the Friday night lights through the Sandhills Patriots youth league. Aspiring young golfers can join programs like US Kids Golf, which is headquartered at Longleaf Golf Club in Southern Pines, or First Tee of the Sandhills.

Moore County is also home to the National Athletic Village, which offers athletic adventures ranging from youth rugby and field hockey programs to dance classes, strength training, archery, summer camps, hiking trails, futsal programs and everything in between. NAV is a membership facility that includes a performance gym.

Finally, there are a handful of local dance studios, some offering classes to children as young as 2 years old, like Terpsichore and L Mace Studios, and others that compete at a high level at national competitions, including 12-time national champions Seven Lakes Dance. Encore Performing Arts Center in Southern Pines offers artistic instruction in dance, music and theater for all ages. Sandhills Gymnastics has been home to competitive gymnastic teams for more than 30 years, but it's probably best known for its Friday Night Fun Gym.









The bases are the perfect distance away: far enough so that county residents aren't disturbed by daily training exercises, but close enough for a quick and easy commute. That leads many military families to move to Moore County. For decades, a significant number of retired military families have also chosen to settle down in Moore County.

It's not only a great setup for military families, it's great for the local economy too. The county's close proximity to several military bases allows for several local defense industries. Along with the continued support of the Moore County Chamber and Moore County Partners in Progress, local defense industries continue to grow and thrive.

The North Carolina Military Business Center, www.ncmbc. us, and MatchForce, www.matchforce.org, are valuable resources available to assist local companies with military business opportunities. The local defense industries bolster the economy to a valuable extent.

Military spouses are also busy working and volunteering in the community, and a number of them have started new businesses. R.Riveter is a prime example: They use military excess materials to fashion a host of high-end leather and fabric designs like handbags, purses, wallets and such. They have a retail store

in Southern Pines, and sell their unique creations across the country via the web.

Retired military members are also making an impact on local businesses. Spartan Blades is a national award-winning maker of high-end utility and collectable knives owned by veterans. As the military population continues to grow, their impact on the local business landscape will as well.

As a way of saying thanks to our troops, several local businesses offer military discounts. Moore County has local chapters of Military Officers Association of America and Sentinels of Freedom, organizations whose missions are "to provide life-changing opportunities for men and women of the U.S. armed forces who have suffered severe injuries and need the support of grateful communities to realize their goals and dreams." Several military appreciation events are held each year.

Our close proximity makes it easy for military men and women to serve their country during the day, and come home for dinner at night. Many grow to love Moore County while in service, and decide to stick around for retirement or to start new businesses. There's not a much better place to be stationed while serving in the U.S. military.



Perhaps the most popular outdoor area in Moore County is Southern Pines Reservoir Park. Exercise runs rampant around the reservoir's 95-acre lake. The man-made trails are great for bikers and runners who want challenging terrain. Residents can get exercise *on* the lake, too. Kayaking is easily accessible, and fishermen can canoe on the lake for some quiet pole reeling. The ongoing Deep River Trails project hopes to establish a series of cycling routes connecting the reservoir to eight other counties, spanning over 350 miles of trails.

There are several other lakes in Aberdeen, Carthage and Whispering Pines that are open to fishermen and kayakers. Head north toward Robbins to kayak and canoe down Bear Creek, Cabin Creek or the Deep River, which also offers river races during the year.

Equestrian and Public Parks

Those looking for something more competitive can check out one of the 18 Moore County public parks. Most have playgrounds for children, as well as public sports facilities for those interested in baseball, disc golf, soccer, tennis and more. Several of the county's municipalities have leagues and teams for adults, and the Moore County Recreation Department ensures kids a place to play and be active through their teenage years.

Not only were the Sandhills made for excellent golf, they were made for excellent horseback riding too. The equestrian opportunities are both high quality and expansive.

The most recent large-scale development is the Carolina Horse Park. It offers over 250 acres of national competition venues, and its nonprofit status ensures local equestrian enthusiasts preservation of recreational horse land. The park hosted the American Eventing Championship its first three years in existence. It's the only facility in the mid-Atlantic region able to host multiple competition disciplines at the championship level, and the organization brings an estimated \$1.5 million into the local economy.

Another prominent local equestrian facility is the Pinehurst Harness Track, which covers over 100 acres of land and has 20 barns. It's a popular spot for winter training because it has sand and clay tracks, which also make it conducive to host other types of events, such as dog races and polocrosse.

Farmers Markets

Ecological developments during the past several years have pushed local economies to "go green." Moore County recognizes the value of such initiatives, and has implemented several plans to support this transition. The county's Farm to Table cooperative has expanded, partnering with local farmers to not only bring fresh produce and goods to consumers, but to local restaurants as well. Farm to Table has already brought together over 1,200 county residents who subscribe to receive produce that's gathered from at least 30 local farmers.

A new initiative is called Farm to Institution, and the goal is to encourage local restaurant owners to use the same produce in their kitchens that consumers enjoy using in their own. This, combined with Moore County's already active farmers markets, creates local environmental awareness that enables a healthy lifestyle and supports the local economy.

Blessing of the Hounds

For the past 100 years, fox hunting and the Moore County Hounds have been a fixture in Moore County, and almost as long as golf. Author James Boyd is credited with starting the hunting practice and subsequent "Horse Country" that developed after he built his home, Weymouth, and invited friends and colleagues to come down and build farms to winter their horses. Now there are dozens of majestic farms in the area around Southern Pines.

A unique annual event called the Blessing of the Hounds is ceremoniously performed in a large field just outside of Southern Pines as a prelude to a hunt. Riders dress in their best red and black coats, with horses groomed and fitted with their shiniest saddles and tack. Several thousand people attend, some tailgating for hours, as the horses and dressed riders prepare to take off. The Moore County Hounds is a privately owned pack of dogs that board nearby. On


