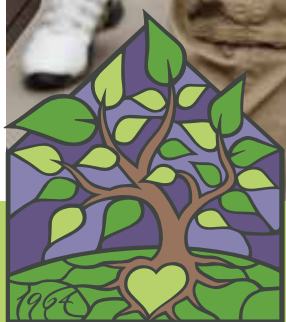

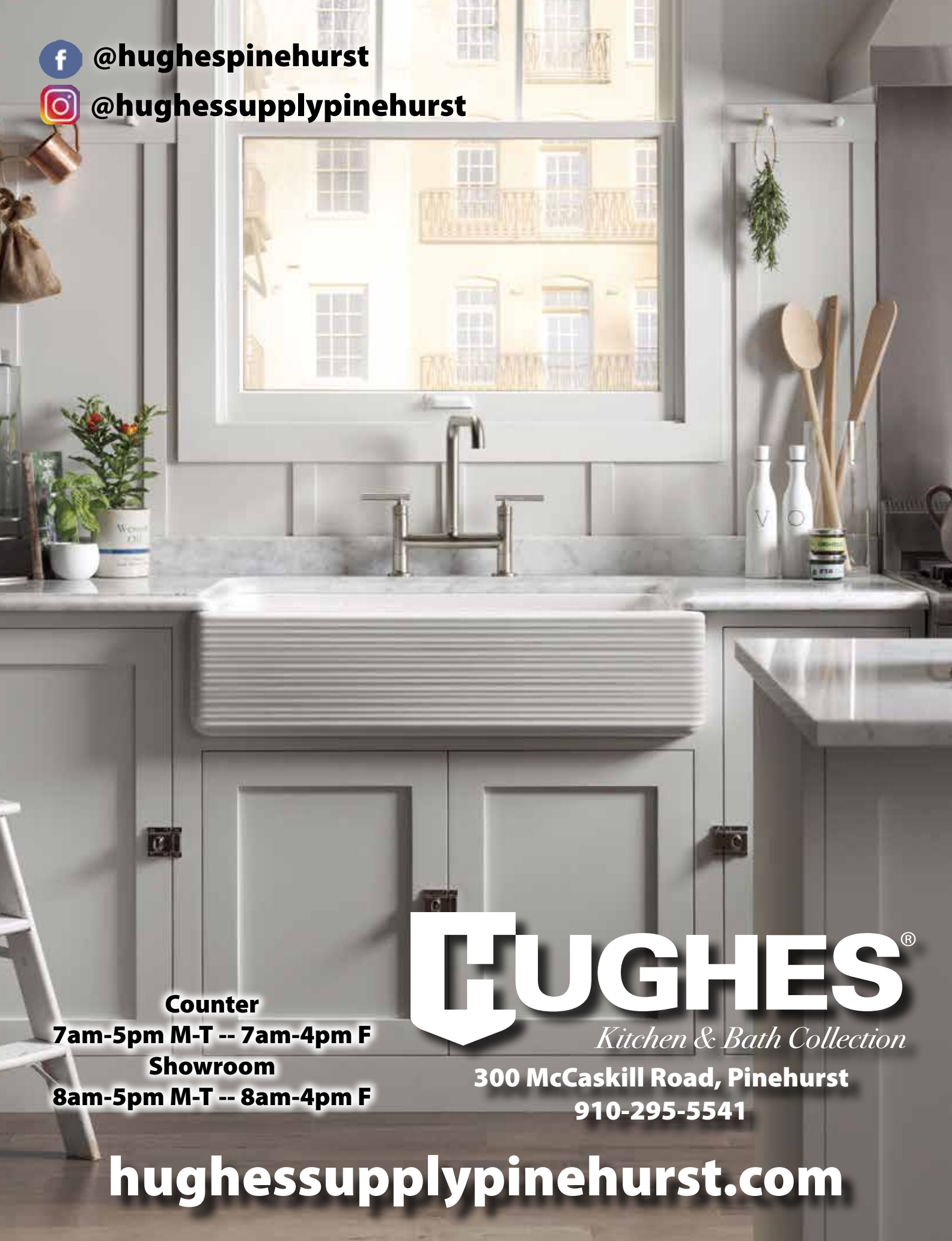

Moore County: A Growing Community and Economy

Moore County is a vibrant and growing community that welcomes new residents and businesses alike. In fact, we've been rated the #1 micropolitan in North Carolina each of the last six years (2018-2023) and are in the top 7% nationally for a stable and consistently growing economy.

Our economic growth is fueled primarily by a consistently growing population. Over the last 20 years, Moore County's population increased by nearly 40%. With a historical annual population growth rate of 2% to 2.5% that has increased to 3% in recent years, Moore County is now the 7th fastest growing county out of 100 counties in North Carolina.

Today, over 105,000 residents call Moore County home, and we are projected to grow to over 170,000 residents by 2050. "With the projected addition of +/- 1,000 new households each year, I expect our existing businesses will continue to expand, other businesses will locate here, and new businesses will be formed in Moore County for the foreseeable future," said Natalie Hawkins, President of Moore County Economic Development Partnership (MCEDP).

Residents and businesses choose to call Moore County home for several reasons. First and foremost, we offer a quality of life that is second to none. From world-class golf courses and exceptional healthcare to vibrant downtowns with boutique shops, farm-to-table restaurants, lively breweries, and ample outdoor recreation opportunities, Moore County has something to offer people of all ages. We are

conveniently located between the beautiful NC mountains and coast, and our residents and businesses can easily access nearby metropolitan areas within a 1-to-2-hour drive.

One key driver of our economic growth is the healthcare industry. Moore County is home to several exceptional regional healthcare providers, including the award-winning FirstHealth of the Carolinas. Headquartered in Pinehurst, FirstHealth serves a 15-county region in the mid-Carolinas and provides top-notch medical care with state-of-the-art facilities not often found in rural America. In fact, their flagship hospital, Moore Regional Hospital, has been named a 100 Top Hospital eight times and was the only hospital in North Carolina to receive this prestigious award the last two years in a row.

Other significant healthcare providers include Pinehurst Medical Clinic and Pinehurst Surgical Clinic. All three of these regional providers have significantly expanded their facilities in Pinehurst and Southern Pines recently to provide advanced medical care. Some of these expansions include the addition of over 200,000 square feet of new medical office space on Morganton Road in Southern Pines and FirstHealth's 120,000 square foot Comprehensive Cancer Center in Pinehurst.

Another key driver of the local economy is tourism. "With over 30 golf courses in a 15-mile radius, our premier golf destination draws 1.5 million visitors to the Home of American Golf® each year. As a result, Moore County's

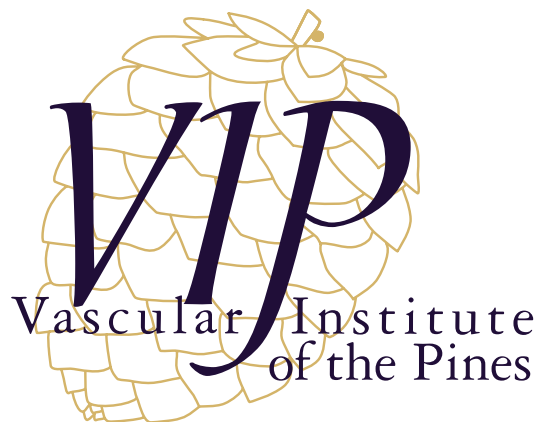

tourism economy is the 10th largest, out of 100 counties, in the state of North Carolina,” said Hawkins.

The globally recognized Pinehurst Resort boasts the famed Pinehurst No. 2 golf course where the U.S. Open Championship will be contested in 2024, 2029, 2035, 2041 and 2047. The economic impact of a single U.S. Open Championship has been estimated at approximately \$400 million statewide. With the rising popularity of golf, Pinehurst Resort is adding a tenth course to its portfolio that will open in the Spring of 2024. This will be the first original golf course Pinehurst Resort has unveiled in nearly 30 years. In addition, the United States Golf Association is constructing its second headquarters in Pinehurst and the World Golf Hall of Fame is returning to Pinehurst next Spring.

While FirstHealth of the Carolinas and Pinehurst Resort are two of Moore County’s largest employers, we also have an expansive entrepreneurial network that stimulates the formation and growth of small businesses. Here entrepreneurs find a collaborative spirit of innovation and creativity. General Info



Building Permits

Building permits must be obtained before any construction or remodeling of an existing building can be undertaken. Prior to any work, contact the local community administrative office for guidelines and permit applications.



Driver's License and License Plates

A driver's license, good for four years, must be acquired within 30 days of becoming a North Carolina resident. When registering for the first time in the state, residents must bring proof of mileage, name of liability insurance company, and policy number as well as previous certificate or title. The license may be obtained from the Driver's License Division of the North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles located at 521 South Sandhills Boulevard (US 1 North) in Aberdeen. For more information, call (910) 944-7555 or visit www.ncdot.org/dmv.

New residents must register a motor vehicle by the expiration of the time granted by the reciprocity agreement between North Carolina and the prior state of residence (usually 30 days) or when gainful employment is accepted, whichever occurs first. For a detailed description of what items are needed when registering a vehicle and the fees required, visit www.ncdot.org/dmv. To register a vehicle, registrants must present a valid North Carolina identification cwaRoad Most Vehicle & License Plate Renewal Offices are open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. A local North Carolina License Plate Agency is located at the Town and Country Shopping Center on US 1 North in Aberdeen. For more information, call (910) 944-1303.

Voting

Voter registration is open to anyone who is 18 years of age and has lived in their district a minimum of 30 days. Registration forms can be picked up at the local libraries, the Department of Motor Vehicles, or the Moore County Board of Elections. The deadline to register to vote in this state is 25 days before the day of the election. Forms that are received by the county Board of Elections office or postmarked by the deadline are accepted as valid applications for the upcoming election. Also, agency and DMV voter registration transactions that are completed by the deadline are accepted as valid for the upcoming election. Applicants will be notified by the county Board of Elections of their precinct and polling place assignments.

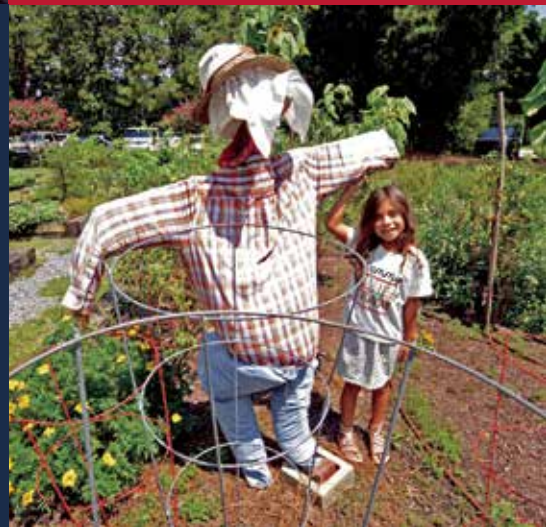

Although more popular at big events and festivals, live entertainment in Moore County is a regular occurrence. Residents have opportunities throughout the year to catch a performance of the Carolina Philharmonic Orchestra, and the Arts Council hosts a Classical Concert Series that brings in talent from all over the world.

For those interested in more contemporary styles of music, Moore County has regular concert series, such as First Friday in Southern Pines, and Live after Five in Pinehurst. Many of these performances offer free admission, and are presented by the county's best venues, such as the Sunrise Theater in Southern Pines. In the spring and summer, artists perform outside to accommodate larger crowds and take advantage of nicer weather.

There are also festivals throughout the year that support local bluegrass bands and Southern rock groups, such as the annual Buggy Festival in Carthage and Farmer's Day in Robbins.

For those who fancy live theater, Broadway shows, ballet and world-renowned speakers, the Given Performing Arts Center at the nearby University of North Carolina at Pembroke offers access to them on one of the finest stages in the state. Carolina Performing Arts Theatre Group is the resident theater company at The Encore Center in Southern Pines. The newly renovated Bradshaw Performing Arts Center at Sandhills Community College brings a variety of live theater, dance and music, as well as the Ruth Pauley Lecture Series.

This series, sponsored by the college, the Moore County League of Women Voters, the American Association of University Women and Moore County Schools, introduces noted speakers to the Sandhills. The goal of the lectures is to deepen understanding of key issues and encourage public participation in their resolution.

Moore County isn't lacking in the literary department either. The Weymouth Center for the Arts and Humanities became home to the North Carolina Literary Hall of Fame in 1996. This exciting cultural trademark was made possible by former Weymouth Center resident James Boyd. He made his living writing and publishing, and has been accredited with launching the "Southern Literary Renaissance" in the 1920s and '30s. Boyd's former study – now known as the Boyd Room – is used to host book readings featuring North Carolina's most talented authors.

The county's artistic flair wouldn't be complete without its historical pottery scene. Residents travel across the county to browse the sprawling selection of clay-made crafts in Cameron and Robbins. In fact, Cameron hosts the biannual Antique and Collectibles Fair to celebrate the vast number of local potters and antique shops.

Moore County's art scene entertains the classics, and recognizes its Southern roots. From traditional art forms to some good ol' bluegrass, residents can engage in a variety of cultural opportunities throughout the year.

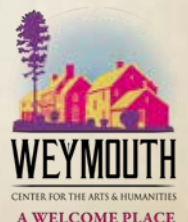

Pritchett called the procedure “a glimpse into the future” of patient care. “It’s exciting to be able to diagnose and treat in a single procedure, but we have the added prospect of creating a systemic response in a patient with metastatic disease, which is a game changer,” he said. “Best of all, the patient went home the same day with a recovery equivalent to a biopsy alone.”

To meet the demand for virtual care services, FirstHealth offers real-time video physician appointments through FirstHealth On the Go.

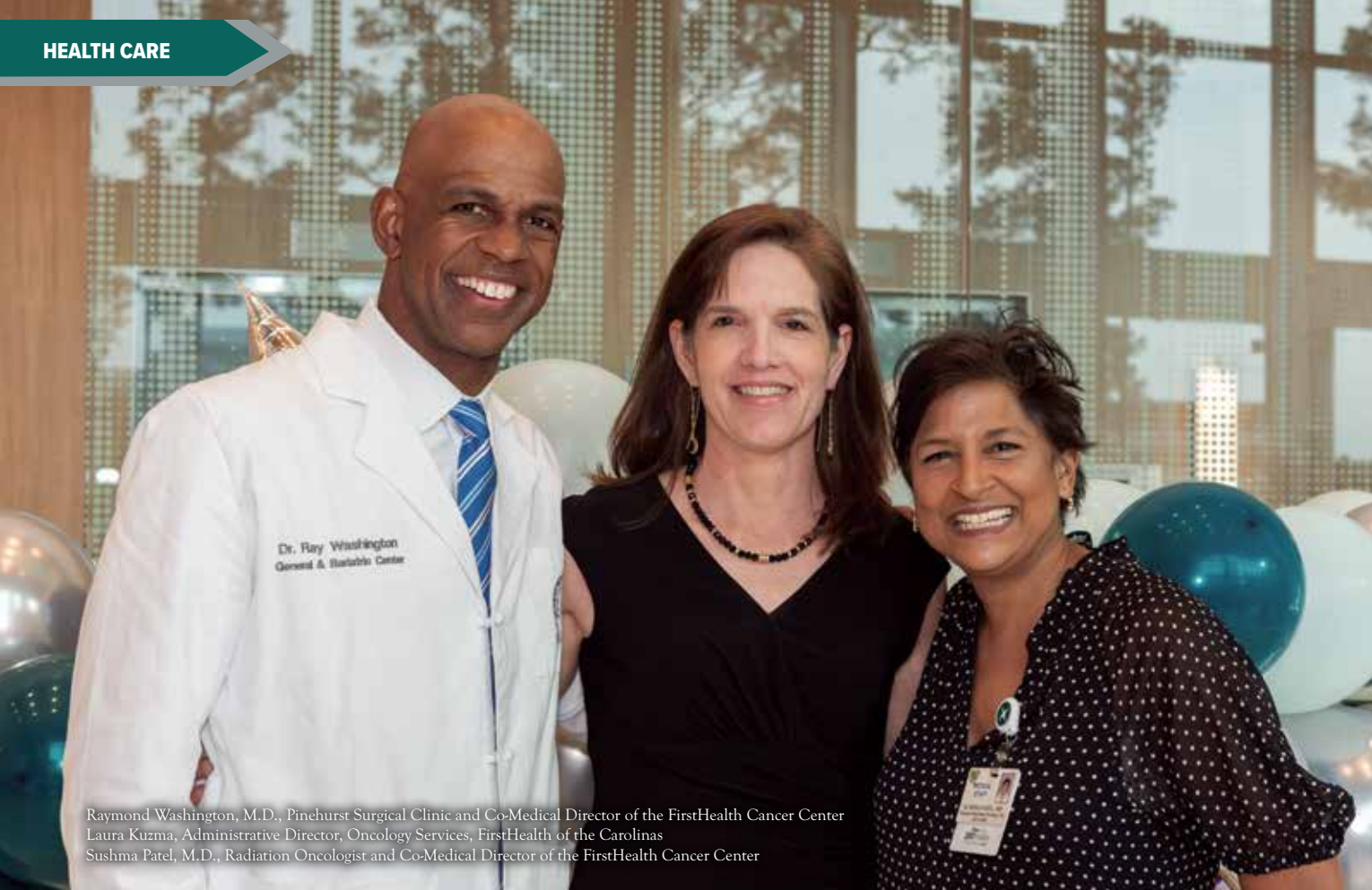

Education

Moore County offers a variety of public and private educational opportunities for K-12 students and is home to one of the most popular community colleges in the state, Sandhills Community College (SCC).



MCS' Strategic Plan incorporates a vision of striving to be the standard for excellence in education in North Carolina, and its mission is for all students to graduate with the skills, knowledge, character, and education necessary to become proud and successful citizens of the United States of America. The county's 23 public schools offer students challenging lessons taught by licensed professionals with years of experience in the field and the classroom. In fact, nearly half of the school system's certified employees have obtained a master's degree or higher in their field of expertise or in teaching.

Before advancing to a K-12 school, it is essential that all children have the opportunity to build early developmental skills that will enhance their success in a rigorous and innovative academic curriculum. MCS utilizes a research-based program called Creative Curriculum in all of its preschool classes, focusing on the principles of early childhood development. Through a partnership with North Carolina's Smart Start program, preschoolers are prepared for success in kindergarten by enhancing readiness in the areas of literacy, basic mathematics, and social-emotional skills.

Moore County Schools' Digital Learning Initiative provides a Chromebook device for all students in grades 6 through 12 for use both in school and at home. Kindergarten through 5th-grade students are given a device (iPad for K-1, Chromebook for 2-5) for use at school with the option to take it home. The initiative aims to ensure students are college and career-ready, offering opportunities for them to showcase mastery





and growth through the creation and publication of digital work. It also aims to immerse students in personalized learning experiences, fostering collaboration, creativity, and publication—all grounded in the core learning standards.

Elementary, middle, and high school teachers actively engage students through a combination of rigorous and innovative teaching methods, providing a dynamic learning environment. The district offers various opportunities to support students in becoming future-ready, with initiatives like the STEM program. This comprehensive initiative includes robotics programs for grades K-8, science kits tailored for K-8 students, CyberPatriot teams operating in all three high schools, and summer STEM camps. These camps serve as gateways, introducing students to a range of STEM-focused careers, including computer programming, forensics, robotics, engineering, forestry, health sciences, and aviation. Moore County Schools are widely acknowledged as leaders in STEM education across the state, a recognition underscored by the receipt of multiple Digital Teaching and Learning Grants from the Department of Public Instruction.

Moore County's excellent high schools make it easy for students to successfully transition into college. SAT scores consistently meet or exceed state and national averages, and all three schools offer Advanced Placement courses, enabling students to start earning college credits in high school. Sandhills Community College also

allows high school students in Moore and Hoke counties to take courses prior to graduation exempt from tuition fees.

In an effort to partner more effectively with Moore County's homeschool population, MCS offers a "blend+ed" program for K-12 students. For grades K-5, students attend face-to-face instruction two days per week, with the remaining days spent on home-based learning. This can involve materials provided by Moore County Schools' teachers or the family's chosen homeschool curriculum. Enrolled students have the option to participate in extracurricular activities, art, music, and physical education classes. For grades 6-12, students can tailor their course load to meet individual needs, using either traditional in-person learning or online classes in coordination with their homeschool curriculum. Students in grades 6-12 in the blend+ed program may also participate in athletics and other extracurricular activities that occur after the normal school day ends.

For a fully virtual option, MCS offers Connect! Virtual Academy. Students learn grade-level content from a certified and fully-licensed MCS teacher at a pace consistent with their peers in face-to-face instruction. Sessions are offered both live and recorded. Virtual students also have the opportunity to participate in athletics and other extracurricular activities that occur after the normal school day ends. 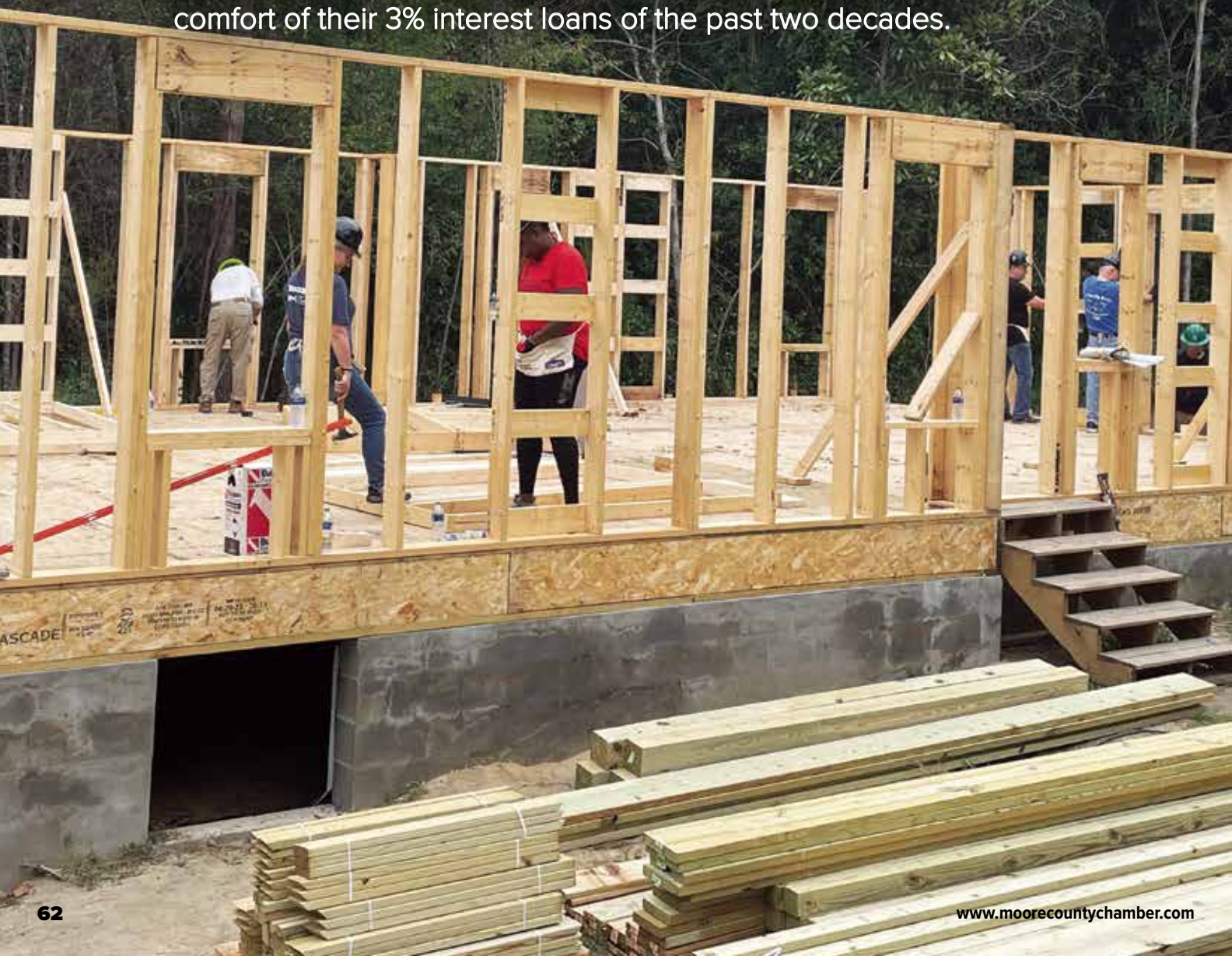

Housing

In the Sandhills

Moore County has seen significant change in the last ten years, especially in housing. Like most of the country, our community continues to feel the impact of post-pandemic life. A combination of Covid, remote employment options, supply chain interruptions of construction material, and instabilities have created unusual supply and demand effects that have strained new construction efforts. Interest rate increases have further halted existing housing availability as homeowners are hesitant to leave the comfort of their 3% interest loans of the past two decades.

In Moore County, 25% of our households are cost-burdened, which means they are paying more than 30% of their income on housing; this includes 43% of our renters and 21% of homeowners. To afford \$913, our county's Fair Market Rent (the cost to rent a moderately-priced 2-bedroom unit in our local housing market), an income of \$36,520 is needed. Unfortunately, average annual salaries for childcare and healthcare workers hover between \$22,000-\$28,000. For many local employees, housing in our county is a challenge. Stories are heard daily about local employers who land a great recruit only to have them decline an offer after unsuccessfully seeking housing. Some may accept and begin working but are living counties away. Travel becomes a burden, and sometimes, an employment option closer to home becomes more attractive.

The good news is we live in a community that recognizes the need to work toward a solution. Even if only for selfish motives, finding ways to build and preserve affordable housing is necessary to ensure the continued vibrancy of our local economy. Not only do individuals show their support for local solutions through our housing nonprofits, but now, our municipalities and for-profit builders are working to get on board with solutions. Sandhills Habitat have always been big on partnership in our community, and some of our recent collaborative efforts will hopefully provide some much-needed relief to our current housing status.

At Habitat for Humanity of the NC Sandhills, we have been privy to increasing housing market challenges for over three decades. The effects of our current housing market are particularly evident due to the demographic of families we serve. Our homebuyers are often the essential workforce in a community, with most homeowners working in the healthcare, education, hospitality and manufacturing sectors. Elevations in the costs of basic needs like housing are especially challenging for our families as they often lack the financial cushion to absorb such fluctuations. While Habitat has been working hard to meet the housing needs of our workforce, the current market is forcing us to look beyond our resources and find ways to engage these concerned partners who care but need viable solutions.

Recently, The Town of Aberdeen traveled up to Chapel Hill with local Habitat for Humanity representatives to meet with the Mayor of Chapel Hill, their Director of Affordable Housing, and Orange County Habitat staff. The town has joined forces with Habitat and local for-profit builders to develop 35 acres of property as a mixed-income community. Bond support from Chapel Hill has provided much of the funding for the infrastructure costs to install utilities and roads. Some of the property was sold to Garmin Homes to be built as single-family detached homes at market rates. Additional parts of the campus are slated for condominiums, also sold at market rates. The Habitat affiliate will build out just over 100 units, primarily single-family attached dwellings, sold with guaranteed affordable mortgages per Habitat mission guidelines. This model interests the Town of Aberdeen as Habitat for Humanity of the NC Sandhills, which covers Moore, Richmond and Hoke counties. It recently purchased over 100 acres of land with a similar vision. Although municipalities in Moore County do not currently have legislative measures to invest in affordable housing, some are open to finding ways we can collaborate to provide our community with the types of housing that seem to be missing.

In addition to the towns, our local building community is also rallying around an idea to further the creation of affordable housing stock in the Sandhills. Known in Habitat world as a "Home Builders Blitz" the effort gathers local builders willing to team up with other builders, subcontractors, and material providers to build a home or multiple homes. Habitat provides the land, handles all the permitting and qualifying of families, and makes the experience fun and engaging. With the first Blitz in over a decade slated for Spring 2024, Habitat hopes the event will garner enough support and excitement to become a staple in the spring building cycle.

Ultimately, it is an exciting time to work in housing, primarily to address the concerns of affordable housing for our workforce. Our community has the potential to set an example for towns across the country as to how we can prioritize housing solutions to preserve the workforce upon which we rely—interested in these ideas? Breweries and Wineries



With the emergence of the craft brewing industry, it's no surprise that Moore County has breweries, wineries, cider houses and a distillery (coming soon) of its own. The trendsetter was Rail House Brewery, which was opened more than a decade ago by veterans in historic downtown Aberdeen. Following suit, three retired Green Berets traded in their boots for barley and started brewing beers like Man of Law IPA and Duck Hook cream ale, opening Southern Pines Brewing Company in late 2014. Both breweries have family friendly taprooms and are hosts to community events throughout the year, including Southern Pines Brewery's Pints and Poses yoga classes, networking mixers and outdoor concerts.

Pinehurst Resort opened a brewery in late 2018 tucked just a few blocks from the resort's Carolina Hotel. It occupies what was the original village steam plant that once powered all of Pinehurst. Boasting the building's original brick facade and steel windows, it is now a restaurant and brewery serving craft beers and barbecue.

Hatcher Brewing Company opened in the fall of 2019 in downtown Southern Pines and with its success is expanding into other markets in North Carolina.

Also expanding is Southern Pines Brewing Company as they are set to open Moore County's newest brewery in the heart of Carthage in 2024. The old Tyson & Jones Buggy Factory building will get a major facelift as it will house a two-story restaurant and taproom with over 50 taps, a small scale brewery, plus a speakeasy and an outdoor stage for live music.

James Creek Cider House harvests 65 varieties of apples in Cameron to create signature small batch ciders that they sell across the state at select bottle shops, farmers markets and locally at area wine shops, pubs and restaurants.

Youth Activities



If your family is into athletics, there are a host of choices available for kids of all ages. Southern Pines, Aberdeen and Pinehurst have thriving recreational departments offering seasonal sport leagues. Additionally, AC Sandhills, a privately run sports league, supports recreational and traveling club soccer, volleyball and lacrosse. The Sandhills Optimist Club offers fall football and spring baseball for ages 6-13, while the Sandhills Lacrosse League has a local travel lacrosse team for high school boys who wish to play at a competitive level. The O'Neal Swim Team is a year-round competitive swim team for all ages. Football players are primed for the Friday night lights through the Sandhills Patriots youth league. Aspiring young golfers can join programs like US Kids Golf, which is headquartered at Longleaf Golf Club in Southern Pines, or First Tee of the Sandhills.

Moore County is also home to the National Athletic Village, which offers athletic adventures ranging from youth rugby and field hockey programs to dance classes, strength training, archery, summer camps, hiking trails, futsal programs and everything in between. NAV is a membership facility that includes a performance gym.

Finally, there are a handful of local dance studios, some offering classes to children as young as 2 years old, like Terpsichore and L Mace Studios, and others that compete at a high level at national competitions, including 12-time national champions Seven Lakes Dance. Encore Performing Arts Center in Southern Pines offers artistic instruction in dance, music and theater for all ages. Sandhills Gymnastics has been home to competitive gymnastic teams for more than 30 years, but it's probably best known for its Friday Night Fun Gym.

Military Life

The southern half of Moore County is linked by location to an important and growing population of men and women in the U.S. armed forces. Part of Fort Liberty is in Moore County, and Pope Army Airfield is only a few miles south of Moore County. Camp Mackall is another training facility used by Special Forces that borders the southern tip of the county. Fort Liberty is one of the largest military installations in the world.



The bases are the perfect distance away: far enough so that county residents aren't disturbed by daily training exercises, but close enough for a quick and easy commute. That leads many military families to move to Moore County. For decades, a significant number of retired military families have also chosen to settle down in Moore County.

It's not only a great setup for military families, it's great for the local economy too. The county's close proximity to several military bases allows for several local defense industries. Along with the continued support of the Moore County Chamber and Moore County Partners in Progress, local defense industries continue to grow and thrive.

The North Carolina Military Business Center, www.ncmbc.us, and MatchForce, www.matchforce.org, are valuable resources available to assist local companies with military business opportunities. The local defense industries bolster the economy to a valuable extent.

Military spouses are also busy working and volunteering in the community, and a number of them have started new businesses. R.Riveter is a prime example: They use military excess materials to fashion a host of high-end leather and fabric designs like handbags, purses, wallets and such. They have a

retail store in Southern Pines, and sell their unique creations across the country via the web.

Retired military members are also making an impact on local businesses. Spartan Blades is a national award-winning maker of high-end utility and collectable knives owned by veterans. As the military population continues to grow, their impact on the local business landscape will as well.

As a way of saying thanks to our troops, several local businesses offer military discounts. Moore County has local chapters of Military Officers Association of America and Sentinels of Freedom, organizations whose missions are "to provide life-changing opportunities for men and women of the U.S. armed forces who have suffered severe injuries and need the support of grateful communities to realize their goals and dreams." Several military appreciation events are held each year.

Our close proximity makes it easy for military men and women to serve their country during the day, and come home for dinner at night. Many grow to love Moore County while in service, and decide to stick around for retirement or to start new businesses. There's not a much better place to be stationed while serving in the U.S. military.

Golf

Golf is and will continue to be the aspect of life in the Sandhills that echoes around the world. In addition to the U.S. Open Championship returning to Pinehurst No. 2 in 2024, there will be hundreds of other tournaments played on its greens in the meantime. Hundreds of thousands of people come to the area from across the world for the sole purpose of savoring the renowned courses in America's "Home of Golf." With more than 40 courses, most of them semi-private, there is a fair test for every player's level, and a favorite hole, view and course from every visit. Pinehurst No. 2 is on every golfer's bucket list.

Golf contributes greatly to the local quality of life because those visitors stay in hotels, eat in restaurants and shop while they are here. There is an old saying in the sport, "If you play golf, you are my friend." Golf has been a friend to this area for more than 100 years, and the sport, more than any single thing, has put Moore County on the world map.

The Great Outdoors

Gardens and Wildlife Areas

Outdoor activities in Moore County are as abundant as they are diverse. There are recreational park facilities for children, and lush gardens for those looking for a pleasant place to walk and relax. For residents who want more rigorous outdoor experiences, Moore County has trails to be hiked and rivers to be conquered by canoes and fishermen.

Sandhills Community College Horticultural Gardens is one of the most beautiful areas in the county. Their winding walkways guide residents through almost 32 acres of gorgeous plant life and shrubbery, all of which fall under 14 unique garden themes. The community college highlights historical significance by lining the trails with information about the county's most treasured botanical features. The garden is maintained by the college's landscape gardening program. It's a popular spot for family pictures and weddings, and serves as a relaxing spot to get some peace and quiet without fully embracing the natural allure of the outdoors.

For a vigorous trail-run, or some entertaining bird-watching in the area's glorious longleaf pine trees, head to the natural area at Weymouth Woods in Southern Pines. It spans almost 900 acres and was North Carolina's first natural area. Its focus is sustaining and promoting plant growth and wildlife rather than facilitating recreational activities like camping and fishing. Weymouth offers weekly trail tours, as well as special events for wildlife enthusiasts, such as guided bird-watches.



Perhaps the most popular outdoor area in Moore County is Southern Pines Reservoir Park. Exercise runs rampant around the reservoir's 95-acre lake. The man-made trails are great for bikers and runners who want challenging terrain. Residents can get exercise on the lake, too. Kayaking is easily accessible, and fishermen can canoe on the lake for some quiet pole reeling. The ongoing Deep River Trails project hopes to establish a series of cycling routes connecting the reservoir to eight other counties, spanning over 350 miles of trails.

There are several other lakes in Aberdeen, Carthage and Whispering Pines that are open to fishermen and kayakers. Head north toward Robbins to kayak and canoe down Bear Creek, Cabin Creek or the Deep River, which also offers river races during the year.

Equestrian and Public Parks

Those looking for something more competitive can check out one of the 18 Moore County public parks. Most have playgrounds for children, as well as public sports facilities for those interested in baseball, disc golf, soccer, tennis and more. Several of the county's municipalities have leagues and teams for adults, and the Moore County Recreation Department ensures kids a place to play and be active through their teenage years.

Not only were the Sandhills made for excellent golf, they were made for excellent horseback riding too. The equestrian opportunities are both high quality and expansive.

The most recent large-scale development is the Carolina Horse Park. It offers over 250 acres of national competition venues, and its nonprofit status ensures local

equestrian enthusiasts preservation of recreational horse land. The park hosted the American Eventing Championship its first three years in existence. It's the only facility in the mid-Atlantic region able to host multiple competition disciplines at the championship level, and the organization brings an estimated \$1.5 million into the local economy.

Another prominent local equestrian facility is the Pinehurst Harness Track, which covers over 100 acres of land and has 20 barns. It's a popular spot for winter training because it has sand and clay tracks, which also make it conducive to host other types of events, such as dog races and polocrosse.

Farmers Markets

Ecological developments during the past several years have pushed local economies to "go green." Moore County recognizes the value of such initiatives, and has implemented several plans to support this transition. The county's Farm to Table cooperative has expanded, partnering with local farmers to not only bring fresh produce and goods to consumers, but to local restaurants as well. Farm to Table has already brought together over 1,200 county residents who subscribe to receive produce that's gathered from at least 30 local farmers.

A new initiative is called Farm to Institution, and the goal is to encourage local restaurant owners to use the same produce in their kitchens that consumers enjoy using in their own. This, combined with Moore County's already active farmers markets, creates local environmental awareness that enables a healthy lifestyle and supports the local economy.

Blessing of the Hounds

For the past 100 years, fox hunting and the Moore County Hounds have been a fixture in Moore County, and almost as long as golf. Author James Boyd is credited with starting the hunting practice and subsequent “Horse Country” that developed after he built his home, Weymouth, and invited friends and colleagues to come down and build farms to winter their horses. Now there are dozens of majestic farms in the area around Southern Pines.

A unique annual event called the Blessing of the Hounds is ceremoniously performed in a large field just outside of Southern Pines as a prelude to a hunt. Riders dress in their best red and black coats, with horses groomed and fitted with their shiniest saddles and tack. Several thousand people attend, some tailgating for hours, as the horses and dressed riders prepare to take off. The Moore County Hounds is a privately owned pack of dogs that board nearby. On Thanksgiving Day, the dogs get the blessing, and the visitors get a beautiful vision of a time lost to most.

Healthy Living

Running clubs have become a popular pastime for enthusiasts, often beginning or ending at neighborhood watering holes like the Southern Pines Growler Shop.

Other group fitness activities found around town include Fit4Mom, Stroller Strides and Sassy Tappers, all sponsored by the village of Pinehurst.

FirstHealth offers the area's largest traditional gym, the FirstHealth Fitness Center in Pinehurst. Other gyms like Anytime Fitness provide around the clock access to members. There are a number of concept studios like CrossFit, Pure Barre and Forte Fitness that each offer unique training models in addition to a wide range of yoga and Pilates studios throughout the community, all helping to ensure that no matter your exercise preference, you'll be able to find your niche in Moore County.
